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Opioid Report

The MRx View Opioid Report uses a proprietary risk score to identify potential problem members with unusual or excessive utilization patterns. For example, members who have utilized multiple pharmacies and multiple prescribers to accumulate controlled substances exhibit a pattern that might suggest potential for abuse of opioid medications.

Our opioid risk score is based on several factors, including:

- Opioid claims
- Doctors who prescribed the opioids
- Pharmacies that dispensed the opioids
- Combination medication claims that could enhance the euphoric effect of opioids or increase the probability of overdose. These include antianxiety, muscle relaxers, hypnotics, antidepressants, and antipsychotics
- Cancer medications (which, when present, typically mean the utilizer is not abusing)

Adherence Report

Taking medications exactly as prescribed (improving adherence) is one of the most important things members can do to enhance their health and prevent medical complications. The MRx View Adherence Report identifies members within certain therapy classes that are not taking their medications as directed. Early identification and successful interventions are key to medication adherence.

MRx View currently tracks adherence in five therapy classes:

- Cardiovascular – Hypertension (Lisinopril, Amlodipine, Losartan, Metoprolol, Atenolol)
- Cardiovascular – Other (Caduet)
- Diabetes (Metformin, Glimepiride, Januvia, Glipizide, Invokana)
- Dyslipidemia (Atorvastatin, Simvastatin, Pravastatin, Crestor, Vytorin)
- HIV/AIDS (Truvada, Genvoya, Atripla, Triumeq, Viread)
